## Subject: Guidelines for admission of Kashmiri Migrants in Polytechnic/ Engineering Colleges/University during the Session 2020-21.

Kindly refer to the subject noted above.

The State Government has considered the guidelines issued by AICTE, New Delhi and Ministry of Human Resources Development, Delhi. Subsequently, the following guidelines are hereby laid for admission of Kashmiri Migrants in Polytechnic/Engineering Colleges/Punjabi University of the State in the following courses:-

## Courses:

(i) Diploma/Degree courses in Polytechnic/Engineering Colleges.
(ii) Diploma/Degree courses and Post Graduation in Pharmacy.
(iii) Post graduate Degree course in Computer Application (MCA).
(iv) Post graduate Degree course in Business Administration (MBA).
(v) Admission in $2^{\text {nd }}$ year Degree course in Engineering (Lateral Entry) from amongst Diploma holders.
(vi) Diploma/Degree course in Hotel Management \& Catering Technology.
3. The following are the guidelines for admission to the above mentioned courses:-
(i) The condition of domicile requirement for Kashmiri Migrants is waived olf.
(ii) One seat in each Polytechnic/Engineering College is hereby created on supernumerary basis for the year 2020-21 of admission of wards of Kashmiri Migrants.
(iii) Admission to various degree levels Engineering Courses shall be made on the basis of inter- se-merit in qualifying examination for the Academic Session 2020-21 and for the other courses on the basis of CMAT-2020/GPAT-2020 Examinations conducted by the National Testing Agency. In respect of courses, where there is no entrance test, the admission shall be made on the basis of marks obtained in $10^{\text {th }} / 10+2 /$ Diploma merit wise. However for the seat of Thapar Institute of Engineering \& Technology, Patiala, the candidate (i) has passed $10+2$ or equivalent examination with at least $70 \%$ marks ( $65 \%$ for SC/ST candidates) in aggregate of three subjects, namely, Physics, Mathematics and any one subject out of Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology and Technical Vocational subject OR Minimum 70\% (65\% for SC/ST candidates) marks in a Diploma recognized by AICTE or a state board of technical education of at least 3 year duration (ii). Possesses a good moral character (iii) Is a citizen of India (iv) Has passed $10+2$ examination in 2018, 2019 or appearing in 2020.
(iv) Application for admission shall be called by the Director, Technical Education \& Industrial Training and seats would be allocated to the students at the earliest possible.
(v) The fees shall be charged as per rates fixed for session 2020-2021 by the State Government/University.
(vi) Each candidate shall have to give proof of his being a Kashmiri Migrant or a ward of Kashmiri Migrant along with the Application Form.
