

A meeting was held on 5-7-2013 at 10.30 a.m. under the Chairmanship of Secretary to Govt. of Punjab, Welfare Department in his office room at PIDB, Sector 34-A, Chandigarh regarding launching of Website-Portal-"Ashirwad". Minutes of the meeting held on 5-7-2013 at 10.30 a.m. under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Welfare regarding Website-Portal-Ashirwad.

List of participants is attached.

Various issues regarding launching of Website-Portal-Ashirwad discussed and decisions were taken as under:-

1. At the outset, Secretary, Welfare briefed the NIC team from Madhya Pradesh regarding the work flow module adopted by the Deptt. of Welfare, Govt. of Punjab.
2. NIC to enter the names of all the Institutes in drop-down box for the selection of institutes by the students while applying online. If the list of courses is not appearing against selected institute, the student has to contact the Institute/Nodal Officer of the implementing Deptt.
3. Only the student will be authorized to change e-mail address, mobile number, bank account number himself by using his user name/password. Institutions will not be authorized to change the bank account details of any students as it may lead to frauds.
4. Reasons for rejection should be entered in the drop-down box. Institutes do not have any right to reject or accept the application. It will only recommend for rejection or acceptance to the sanctioning authority. The sanctioning authority will take the final call whether to accept or reject the student application based on the rules and recommendations by the institute.
5. Sanctioning Authorities to be registered by the implementing departments and User ID's & Passwords to be generated within a week and to be mapped with the institutes.
6. Implementing Deptts. to oversee the charging of fee from students by the institutes particularly private institutes. Once fee fixed, will not be changed during the session.
7. Updating of new courses, number of sanctioned seats & fee structure will be the responsibility of the Line Deptts. NIC to make provision in the Software.
8. Provision should be made in Software by NIC regarding entering of Bank A/c & IFS Code of bank branch twice manually in the student login as well as Institute login to avoid mistakes.

9. Implementing Deptts. to ensure that "Institute details" are entered by the institutes who got User ID's & Passwords and report to Welfare Deptt. by 10th July, 2013. Entering of Bank A/c & IFS Code is mandatory for the institutes.
10. In case of schools, NIC was advised to enter all streams-Arts, Science, Commerce and Technical & Vocational in the "Institute Details". Similarly in the case of degree colleges, DPI (Colleges) can get it done.
11. Line Deptts. should also conduct work-shops at field level to educate the schools/institutes regarding the operation of Website-Portal.
12. NIC to make the provision for entering new IFSC of new/left out bank branches by the implementing Departments.
13. Directorate of Technical Education has two separate wings-TE Wing and ITI Wing. Nodal Officers had requested to generate separate User ID's/Passwords for these wings. NIC was agreed to do it.
14. Sanctioning Authorities to forward the sanctioned applications in small batches of 100 or so to the Line Deptts. and the sanctioned amount should be in words also. The Line Deptts. can down-load the sanctioned sheets and forward to Welfare Deptt., duly signed.
15. Scholarship portal of Punjab will also provide facility for the Welfare Department and all the Line Departments to download the list of students who have been sanctioned the scholarship in the format specified by Govt. of India in excel format in date range so that it can be used for digital signing and sharing it with any one. Scholarship portal of Punjab will make a provision to sign the same.
16. NIC to display list of sanctioned students after the issuance of sanction by the Sanctioning Authority. If there is any complaint in between about student/institute claiming wrong scholarship, the line deptt. can hold back the whole batch & initiate the inquiry to arrive at the facts.
17. NIC was also advised to change the FAQ'S- For students and For Institutes inconsonance with the modifications to be made in the software.
18. Complaint resolution matrix will be finalized by NIC in consultation with Deptt.of Welfare.
19. For students residing/ studying outside state, given correspondence address- in the combo box containing the district names and "Others" option will be

included and the student can write the name of his/her district in the address text box.

20. Change in footer- "Designed by NIC MP" should be replaced by "Designed by NIC" in the footer.
21. The formats for generating MIS reports will be finalized by Deptt. of Welfare/Implementing Deptts. as per their requirements.
22. Payment of fees and maintenance allowance will be done one time to the institutes and students respectively.
23. Student login will be enabled on 8-7-2013.
24. At the end, NIC advised all Implementing Departments to inform the Schools/Institutes not to share their Passwords with students or any other outside agency.

In partial modification of the Punjab Government Notification No. 13/30/2003/1TE2/1240, dated 01.04.2003 & No. 13/127/09/1TE2/2050, dated 13.05.2010, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to revise the rates of tuition fee w.e.f. the academic session 2011-2012 as under:-

These rates shall be applicable from the session 2011-2012 and the previous rates of fee shall continue to be applicable on already admitted students during past years.

Fee and charges other than the tuition fee, should be determined by Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar, but the University should ensure that these fees and charges are not exorbitant and do not fulfil profit motives of any of the colleges in the State.

If any of the colleges affiliated to Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar wish to charge fee less than the fee prescribed by the Government, they can do so, provided such a reduced fee should be charged uniformly without any discrimination.
